

WhimsyKnits Patterns

Triple Threat Toddler Hat



Yarn: Worsted weight, 3 strands held together
Needles: US#17
Gauge: 2 stitches/inch

For charity purposes gauge is not of great importance, your hat is sure to fit some child who would otherwise have a cold head.

This hat is knit on two needles and then seamed.

Cast on 30 stitches.

Rnd 1: Knit

Rnd 2: *K1, P1* repeat between *'s across

Rnd 3: Repeat rnd 2

Rnd 4: (RS) Knit – increase 2 sts on this rnd, distribute evenly

Rnd 5: (WS) Purl

Rnds 6-11: Repeat rnds 4 and 5

Decrease rnds:

Rnd 1: K2, K2tog across

Rnd 2: Purl

Rnd 3: K1, K2tog across

Rnd 4: Purl

Rnd 5: K2tog across

Finishing: Using a tapestry needle thread yarn ends through the remaining sts on the needle, pull tight. Seam the back of the hat. Weave in ends.
